

For more than 30 years, Family Promise Montco PA has served vulnerable families with children in Montgomery County experiencing homelessness and food insecurity. With strong roots in civic engagement and community collaboration, Family Promise Montco helps families move to a more stabilized living situation by providing emergency shelter, transitional and supportive housing, case management, referral services, and food distribution.

## Our Programs Include...

### Emergency Shelter (Interfaith Hospitality Network)

We provide emergency shelter in partnership with a network of local host congregations. Families contact Your Way Home, Montgomery County's centralized intake system, to be referred to the program. Congregation volunteers bring and share meals with families, provide overnight assistance, and help with transportation.



### Transitional Housing (Hope Gardens)

Hope Gardens, established in 1995, is a transitional housing program for families who are at risk of or who have experienced homelessness. Tenants pay rent, are responsible for apartment utilities, participate in education programs, establish savings, and continue case management. The Hope Gardens building has eight apartments, including 2-, 3-, and 4-bedroom units.

### Supportive Housing (Hope Forest & Hope on Fifth)

Created in 2016, Hope Forest serves families who have successfully completed either an emergency shelter or transitional shelter program. In 2021, Hope on Fifth in Lansdale became our second supportive housing location. Supportive housing is intended to offer a lighter touch of support and be a bridge from temporary housing to permanent self-sufficiency. During their stay, families pay rent, increase their income, and continue to develop skills, resources, and relationships that will prevent future homelessness and promote economic independence.



### Food Pantry

The Family Promise Food Pantry supports individuals and families in Montgomery County who are experiencing food insecurity. The food pantry is located on the property of Salem Baptist Church, 2801 Woodland Road, Roslyn. Hours for donation and distribution are Monday 5:30 PM - 7:30 PM and Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday 10:00 AM - 1:00 PM.
